Task 2

- Solve this logic problem:

- It is a five-digit number.

 The sum of all the digits is 24

Task 3

Task 4

Geography – Write a Fact File of a famous environmentalist. What have they achieved in their life? How have they helped the environment? Examples a people are: Greta Thunberg and David Attenborough.

Task 5

English – Can you write a list of animals A-Z and add an adjective which begins with the same letter. For example Marvellous monkey. Then can you write 5 sentences to include these thinking about adding fronted adverbials and making it into a more detailed sentence.

Task 6

ART – Typography – Can you create a map of your house and annotate the rooms. You might want to do two separate ones for upstairs and downstairs.
